Interns will assist staff in systematic research of collection information to support the operations of the Archaeology section. This support will assist staff by working to do site research to determine a better understanding of the collections.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Critically review and analyze collection information to determine NAGPRA eligibility.
- Assist with preparing documentation for Tribal consultation.
- Present a final project report at the Intern Expo on July 25.

Requirements:

- Background in Archaeology or a closely related field is preferred.
- Computer knowledge.
- Strong organizational skills and attention to detail.
- Dependable.
- Compliance with confidentiality.

Time Commitment:

This internship spans from June 3 to July 26, with a minimum requirement of 160 hours. The working hours are flexible, Mondays through Fridays, between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. The specific schedule will be established in accordance with the availability and mutual agreement between the intern and MDAH staff.
